Welcome to the 2023 Minocqua Antique & Classic Boat Show LLC (MACBS) and to the famed Minocqua Chain of Lakes. After our inaugural event at our new Torpy Park location, we are gearing up for a bigger and better event in 2023.

This year we are going to hold the show over two (2) days, Friday and Saturday, June 16th & 17th, 2023. This is going to be a busy weekend in the area so be sure to reserve hotel space immediately. We will again utilize most of Torpy Park including the now newly landscaped lawn areas and the waterfront. Last year we introduced our six new 48 foot long piers.
